We have developed qualifications according to Qualification and Credit Framework (QCF) requirements and guidance in information security, computer science and business studies at Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels. Our qualifications are approved by the UK Universities and provide progressions to UK Masters Degree programs.

Course Aim and Modules

The course has a flexible modular structure and consists of eight core subjects. A particular emphasis is given in achieving an optimal balance of theory and practice; students will be given exposure to leading-edge software and assurance practices. The course modules are as follows:

IS Audit Process; Information System Management; Infrastructure and Operations of IS; Security of IS Infrastructure; Business Continuity and Disaster Recovery; Software Engineering and Security Architecture; Information Risk Management; Scientific Writing & Research Methodology

The University of Gloucestershire (UoG)

UoG has approved AISABE's Level 7 Diploma in Information Security and Assurance with 120 CTS (equivalent to QCF 80 CTS). Students holding AISABE Level 7 ISA qualification can join UoG for MSc Computing with Systems Security Management Degree programs at Dissertation stage (60 credits) to obtain full Masters Degree. www.glos.ac.uk

The University of Chester (UoC)

Chester accepts AISABE's Level 7 Diploma PgD in Information Security and Assurance with 120 CTS (equivalent to QCF 80 CTS). Students holding AISABE Level 7 ISA qualification can join Chester's online / distance learning MSc Degree programs at Dissertation stage (60 credits) to obtain full Masters Degree. Chester offers work based online Masters Degree (Top Up), which gives students a right to negotiate or chose their Title for Masters Degree such as MSc in Information security and Assurance. www.chester.ac.uk

Anglia Ruskin University (ARU)

ARU has approved AISABE's Level 7 Diploma in Information Security and Assurance (ISA) with 105 CTS (equivalent to QCF 70 CTS). Students holding AISABE Level 7 ISA qualification can join ARU for MSc Network Security Degree program, where students would be required to complete a Research Method module and Dissertation (75 credits) to obtain full MSc Degree. www.anglia.ac.uk
